


### **Product Description**

Sirenza Microdevices' SGA-2263 is a high performance SiGe HBT MMIC Amplifier. A Darlington configuration featuring 1 micron emitters provides high  $F_{\scriptscriptstyle T}$  and excellent thermal perfomance. The heterojunction increases breakdown voltage and minimizes leakage current between junctions. Cancellation of emitter junction non-linearities results in higher suppression of intermodulation products. At 850 Mhz and 20mA , the SGA-2263 typically provides +20.2 dBm output IP3, 14.7 dB of gain, and +7.5 dBm of 1dB compressed power using a single positive voltage supply. Only 2 DC-blocking capacitors, a bias resistor and an optional RF choke are required for operation.





#### **Mounting Instructions**

- 1. Use a large ground pad area near device pins 1, 2, 4, and 5 with many plated through-holes as shown.
- We recommend 1 or 2 ounce copper. Measurements for this data sheet were made on a 31 mil thick FR-4 board with 1 ounce copper on both sides.

#### Part Identification Marking

The part will be marked with an "A22" designator on the top surface of the package.



Pin #	Function	Description
3	RF IN	RF input pin. This pin requires the use of an external DC blocking capacitor chosen for the frequency of operation.
1, 2, 4, 5	GND	Connection to ground. Use via holes for best performance to reduce lead inductance as close to ground leads as possible.
6	RF OUT/ BIAS	RF output and bias pin. DC voltage is present on this pin, therefore a DC blocking capacitor is necessary for proper operation.




